Turning Point offers detox treatment for adults who are addicted to alcohol or drugs, including, those who also struggle with mental illness ("co-occurring disorders"), those who cannot afford to pay for treatment, women who are pregnant, and women who have just had a baby. Clients with co-occurring disorders (substance use and mental health disorders) are detoxified from alcohol or opiates and stabilized on their psychotropic medication.
